-Clare and Dave are requesting a 1.5 to 2 year term extension due to the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary event and would like a silent vote/poll of the populace regarding this to occur after Christmas. Survey Monkey was suggested as a way of doing this.

-Lucky Bob has requested information that he can use to add to the website because much of the content from the old website was lost due to changing providers and losing access to the server with the information.
