October 15 2017 Folkmoot Minutes

Old business

-C4 – We don't have a table for C4. Joyce from The Highland Gathering will share space with us. Dave has a laptop with videos to set up. People volunteered to work at the table. Thanks volunteers!

-12th Night 2018 – Bid put forth for January 6th at the Clifton site. Looking for people interested in running A&S classes. Fighting will be “bring your own marshal” and there will be space available. Feast is planned as being a 12 dish Ukrainian feast. Site fees will be \$10 (\$5 with membership), children (under 18) are free. Feast will be \$20 for adults, \$10 for ages 6-12, and those 5 and under are free. Plans include an archery shoot on Friday at a cost of \$10 per shooter (equipment rental not included). Merchants are encouraged to preregister to be certain of a table space. This was voted on and passed.

-A&S – Regular meetings, people are coming out.

-Gimli 2018 - Bid put forth. The theme is planned as Roman with colour factions, archery, chariot races, games, etc. There likely will not be fighting. The full weekend costs (includes feast, breakfast Sat and Sun, and dinner Sun, overnight fees, site fee) will be Adults \$85, Children 5-12 \$50, Children 4 and under \$35, infants are free. New business

-Fight practice planned with Thunder Bay/Mare Amethystinum folks for November 19th here in Winnipeg. We need to provide a marshal and crash space for probably 3 fighters Saturday night. If you want to come out and fight or are at all interested in information about it – this is the time to come out. Bring your own cup/jock or jill if you want to try it out. There should be loaner gear available. We will check if they want to do archery on Sat. We also need to ask the fighters from Sigelhundas if they would like to come. The Thunder Bay fighters also plan to come out in the spring and for the Cooks Creek demo.

-Gimli 2019 discussed. It will be called “Highway to L”, with a theme of The Silk Road, and Amy is looking for a co-Autocrat for it. So far the plans are for a standard Gimli – archery, feast, fighting if there are fighters, youth activities, etc.

-Are people interested in a group run for arrow supplies? Please get your names to Tammy/THL Racheel. Possibly looking at a Wednesday.

-Does the Barony want to supply loaner arrows? If so do we want to buy now and what would the cost be? Robin and Lucky Bob offered to donate arrow shafts. Motion to fund up to \$50 towards loaner arrows. This was passed.

-Youth combat – We have the rules now and are looking at starting in the spring or possibly having some at 12th Night. We are looking for donations of one-piece hockey helmets and also need soft knee and elbow pads. Looking at requesting \$50 towards building gorgets and swords. Need to check on costs. Will be contacting Peregrine and Patrick for patterns etc.

-Sewing bee – A fabric run is being planned for November 18, 1:00 pm. (*At the time of the meeting the date was TBA but has since been decided.*) The plan is to go to Marshall Fabrics on Berry. Please contact Dawn/Lady Cristina so everyone can go together. Sewing bee dates are TBA and will be Fridays or weekends. There is a cat in the home where the sewing bee will be held.

New business

-Online weaving supply order from <https://janestaffordtextiles.com/> - Dawn/Lady Cristina has samples. They carry cotton, silk, wool, and linen. The order is planned to go in after Christmas and if the order is for over \$250 and we receive free shipping, 10% off & free shipping if it is over \$500.

-Wildgard wants to share winter hall rentals again – this was agreed upon.

-Ukrainian camp site updates - Renovations for bathrooms are starting. Handicap accessible stall, shower, etc being put in. We are considering making a donation towards the renovation costs when the renovations are finished as well as organizing a work day in the spring to help.

-We are looking for locations for Spring Coronation 2018. Ideas from the populace were requested. It was agreed that we still want to put in a bid with a date of April 14 2018. The 715 Telfer Street North location is not an option. The curling club was suggested. Another possible hall would require a minimum of 150 people to attend or we would lose money. *(Since this meeting the Coronation bid was won by another group and we are now considering putting in a bid for either Fall Crown or Spring Coronation 2019.)*
